



## Wine of the Month 2014 True Myth Cabernet Sauvignon

### About the Winery

Jack Niven came to San Luis Obispo in the early 1970s with the vision to plant a vineyard in what was then a valley of dairy farms and garbanzo beans. After working with the top viticulture professors from UC Davis and Fresno State, he determined the perfect location and planted the Paragon Vineyard in 1973. Home to the oldest continually producing Chardonnay vines in the region, the Niven family has owned and farmed this vineyard for more than 40 years. Jack later went on to petition to establish Edna Valley as an official American Viticultural Area (AVA) in 1982. The second and third generations of the Niven family have since continued his legacy. Today their portfolio focuses on exploring the endless potential and diversity in their historic Paragon Vineyard and throughout San Luis Obispo County.

### About the Wine

This Cabernet Sauvignon is pure Paso Robles, full of polished aromas of blackberry, cherry and vanilla, leading to flavors of dark red uits, black currants and hints of pepper, cocoa powder and caramelized oak. Rich yet smooth, this wine is very approachable now, and will continue to mature for years to come.

## Wine of the Month 2015 Nelms Road Red Blend

### About the Winery

In 1998, Woodward Canyon Winery began producing wines under a second label, Nelms Road. Nelms Road offers a red blend and cabernet sauvignon from Walla Walla Valley and Washington State grapes. It was developed to produce delicious and affordable red wine from young vineyards and surplus lots of Woodward Canyon Winery production. While these wines may be cellared for several years, they are truly ready for enjoyment now.

This new bottling of 2015 Nelms Road Red Wine reflects the vintage well. Woodward Canyon Estate Vineyard is the predominant vineyard for this new red blend which is primarily Cabernet Franc and Merlot. Add to that some truly phenomenal press wine from some of the oldest and most celebrated vineyards in Washington State and we can produce a truly remarkable red wine at a moderate price point.

### About the Wine

The very warm 2015 vintage gave beautifully ripe yet balanced fruit with enticing flavors of black cherry, mocha and baking spice. Complex aromas of roasted meat, black fruits and tobacco integrate, leading to a soft generous finish. The wine is purple in color and has lovely texture; and though it was bottled early to retain fruit, is quite enjoyable now. This red blend will improve substantially with additional time in bottle and with proper storage should age well for five years or more.

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## Wine of the Month **Perelada Cava Brut Rosado**

### About the Winery

Wine has been made at the Castillo Perelada since the Middle Ages, as shown in several documents and parchments from the period to be found in the library. When Miguel Mateu bought this ensemble of monuments in 1923, one of his primary objectives was to revitalize the wine producing tradition, a tradition that is more alive than ever these days and which has incorporated the most modern technology to create wines that make full use of the nuances of the soils and vines of the Empordà.

### About the Wine

Delicate red cherry aromas. Soft ripe strawberries and creamy vanilla ice cream on the palate with a core of acidity. Elegant mousse and a long length. Cava Castillo Perelada Rosado, a great favourite of the brilliant Salvador Dalí, is born of a blend of Trepat (Grenache), Monastrell (Mourvèdre) and Pinot Noir. With floral and fruity aromas, it adds a touch of colour. Pale cherry red. Clean and bright. Its generous stream of fine bubbles forms a crown. It has a fruity aroma with a slight ageing tone. This wine has a complex and fruity taste, sweet and with a good balance in the mouth.

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## Wine of the Month 2014 Talley Chardonnay

### About the Winery

Talley Vineyards is a small family-owned and operated winery located in the Arroyo Grande Valley on California's South Central Coast. This valley opens directly to the Pacific Ocean, making it one of the coolest and most temperate viticultural areas in California. The goal at Talley Vineyards is to produce estate bottled Chardonnay and Pinot Noir of uncompromising quality. Talley Vineyards is committed to the primacy of terrior in its wines, and every step taken from vine to bottle is reflective of this approach.

### About the Wine

The signature white wine of Talley Vineyards, the Estate Chardonnay represents a pure expression of the calcareous soils and cool maritime climate of the Arroyo Grande Valley produced in a classic old world style, incorporating barrel fermentation and aging. This bottling dates to the inaugural vintage of 1986 and was the first Chardonnay produced in the Arroyo Grande Valley.

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
